- 4. The work must be provided with the name of the participant.
- 5. All the materials and equipment to be used can be found on the spot. There is a limited amount of materials available for each slot.
- 6. The working time is two hours maximum **NO POSSIBILITY FOR EXTENSION**. However, the participant can finish the work earlier or may be excused to visit another site providing the supervisors are notified and are aware of the situation.
- 7. At the registration the participant is liable to inform the officials if the participant wants to take the work along. In case not, the work will be recycled.
- 8. There are no limitations for your creativity and high spirits! Be happy and make the most of the situation. The main thing is TO BE HERE!
